

TEXAS SOCIETY OF PROFESSIONAL SURVEYORS DEEP EAST TEXAS CHAPTER NO. 6

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERION

I. FINANCIAL DETAILS:

- A) The amount of each scholarship shall be \$500, up to an annual maximum of \$2,500. The intent is to grant three educational scholarships to graduating high school seniors and two surveying short course scholarships. However, the Chapter reserves the right to increase the amount of any scholarship and also reserves the right to award a scholarship to students already enrolled in an institution, being a minimum of three educational scholarships and a maximum of two surveying short course scholarships, shall be \$500.00. In the event the short course scholarships are not awarded, those funds may be applied to additional educational scholarships or used to increase an already awarded educational scholarship.
- B) Payments shall be made in one installment and shall be made in the name of the recipient.
- C) Payments shall be made on or just prior to the beginning of the recipients first semester for educational scholarships or at time of early registration for the short course scholarships.

II. SELECTION CRITERION:

A) EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1. The recipient must be a member of a graduating high school class located in Hardin, Jasper, Jefferson, Newton, Orange or Tyler Counties, Texas.
- 2. The recipient must have been accepted as a student at an institution of higher learning with a personal emphasis in study and course scheduling relative to a surveying profession or career. The intention being to financially aid students with a desire and intention of entering into or desiring to enter into the surveying profession.
- 3. A committee of five (5) TSPS Chapter 6 members shall carry out selection of a recipient. The Chapter President shall appoint three committee members. The Chapter Secretary shall appoint the remaining two committee members.

4. Selection of a recipient by the committee shall be final and not subject to open chapter approval. The chapter may be advised of the scholarship recipient but the Scholarship Committee shall be the governing body and voice for the chapter.

B) SHORT COURSE SCHOLARSHIP:

1. The recipient must be in the hire of an engineering or surveying firm located in Hardin, Jasper, Jefferson, Newton, Orange or Tyler Counties, Texas, with an emphasis on surveying.
2. The recipient must be of good character with a sincere desire to advance his or her skills in the surveying profession.
3. A committee of five (5) TSPS Chapter 6 members shall carry out selection of a recipient. The Chapter President shall appoint three committee members. The Chapter Secretary shall appoint the remaining two committee members.
4. Selection of a recipient by the committee shall be final and not subject to open chapter review or approval.
